Writing and Reading	<p>This half term we will be reading Cottonwool Colin by Jeanne Willis, On the way home by Jill Murphy and our Non-fiction text Red Alert! By Catherine Barr. Our poem for this half term is Cake-O-Saurus by Celia Warren. In our writing lessons we will focus on writing to describe and poetry. We will also be creating our own stories based on one of the class books. We will also focus on the use of finger spaces, capital letters and using full stops independently. We will also be starting the term off by reading the whole school text: Rain before Rainbows by Simriti Halls.</p>	Science	<p><b><u>Seasonal changes</u></b></p> <p>In science, the children will be using the scientific skill of observing changes over time. Children will observe the four seasons and the weather associated with each season. Children will be able to talk about the different clouds in different seasons, measure rain fall and complete simple tests.</p>	Music	In music this half term, the children will continue to work with the wonderful Mr. Fisher – our music specialist. They will sing a range of songs and learn about key notations, rhythm and pulse.
	Phonics		<p>During phonics we will carry on learning our phase 5 sounds and recapping the alternative sounds.</p>	<p><b><u>Attack and Defend</u></b></p> <p>Children will practice basic movements and engage in competitive activities.</p> <p><b><u>Dance</u></b></p> <p>Children will explore space and directions. Children will respond to different types of music and create performances using different body parts.</p>	PSHE
Maths		In maths, the children will start to recognise, compose, decompose and move 2D and 3D shapes. Children will start the term observing block pattern images and tangrams. We will then start to partition numbers to 10 in different ways. Children will start to use mathematical words to answer reasoning questions. They will practise recalling number facts to 10 and practise counting forwards and backwards to 100.	PE	<p><b><u>Art Clay</u></b></p> <p>This term we are going to be creating our own clay animal inspired by Henry Moore. Children will focus on the following question: How can clay be manipulated to create a sculpture? Children will learn techniques for working with clay and assess their final product.</p>	Computing
		Art/Design		RE	<p><b><u>Judaism</u></b></p> <p>This term we will look at the religion of Judaism. We will find out what Jewish people believe about God and the importance of Joseph. The children will be using the skill of discussion to talk about the beliefs of different people.</p>
