


Year 1 Curriculum Web – Autumn 2 2021

Writing and Reading  <p>This half term we will be reading Traction Man by Mini Grey, Rhinos Don't Eat Pancakes by Anna Kemp and Six Dinner Sid by Inga Moore. In our writing lessons we will focus on writing a recount, start to look at the features of a letter and carry on building on our descriptive writing from last term. We will be developing our handwriting and use of finger spaces, as well using capital letters.</p>	Science <p><u>Everyday Materials</u></p> <p>In science, the children will learn to name a variety of everyday materials. They will develop the following scientific skills: how to distinguish between an object and the material in which it is made, to describe physical properties of a material and to compare and group a variety of everyday materials.</p>	Music <p><u>Rhythm</u></p> <p>In music this half term, the children will continue to work with the wonderful Mr. Fisher – our music specialist. They will sing a range of songs and learn about key notations, rhythm and pulse. We will also start to practice songs for our winter performance.</p>
		PSHE <p><u>Relationships</u></p> <p>In PSHE lessons, we will be identifying how our behaviour can make people feel, the difference between being kind and unkind, what is fair and unfair and how we can show respect.</p>
Phonics <p>During phonics we will start to learn the Phase 5 sounds below.</p> <p>/ir/ /ie/ /ue/ /u/</p>	PE <p><u>Hit, catch, run</u></p> <p>Children will work on their teamwork skills to field effectively and look to hit in the correct location.</p> <p><u>Gymnastics</u></p> <p>Children will start to sequence different shapes when jumping. They will learn how to use apparatus correctly and safely.</p>	Computing <p><u>Creating Media – Digital Painting</u></p> <p>This half term, the children will develop their understanding of a range of tools used for digital painting. They then use these tools to create their own digital paintings, while gaining inspiration from a range of artists' work.</p>
		RE <p><u>Christianity</u></p> <p>This half term, the children will learn about Christianity and what Christmas is and why it is celebrated by Christians.</p>
Maths <p>In maths, the children will be learning about comparison of quantities and measurements. Using the mathematical vocabulary of more and less. They will practise recalling number facts to 5 and practise counting forwards and backwards to 100.</p>	Art/Design <p><u>Design and technology</u> <u>Mechanics: Drawbridges.</u></p> <p>This term we are going to be creating our own functioning drawbridges. We will look at some famous drawbridges found in the UK and discuss what tools we will need.</p> <p>We will be learning the skill of evaluating our own work and the work of other people.</p>	Geography <p><u>Home sweet home</u></p> <p>In geography we will learn the following knowledge: where am I in the world. The children will understand where they live in the world and identify any physical and humans features around them. This half term we will learn the following skills: To use and understand maps, follow maps of our local area, name and locate the four countries of the United Kingdom.</p>
