Writing and Reading	 <p>This term we have a range of books from 'A walk in London' by Salvatore Rubbino, 'Just Ducks' by Nicola Davies, 'The Worst Princess' by Ann Kemp and 'Hector and the Big Bad Knight' by Alex. T Smith. In our writing lessons, we will continue to write for different purposes. We will focus on writing a recount, build on our letter writing skills and write a set of instructions.</p> <p>During phonics we will carry on learning our phase 5 sounds and recapping the alternative sounds.</p> <p>/ie/ /a/ /e/ /o/ /i/ /ow/</p>	Science	<p><u>Animals including humans</u></p> <p>In science, we are going to be learning the names of some common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will also learn about the structure of a variety of animals and identify what animals eat.</p>	Music	In music this half term, the children will continue to work with the wonderful Mr. Fisher – our music specialist. They will sing a range of songs and learn about key notations, rhythm and pulse.
				PSHE	<p><u>Living in the wider world</u></p> <p>In PSHE lessons, we will be discussing what we are good at and what we would like to be when we are older and how this will help others.</p>
Phonics		PE	<p><u>Attack and Defend</u></p> <p>Children will practice basic movements and engage in competitive activities.</p> <p><u>Gymnastics</u></p> <p>Children will be able to use basic gymnastic actions and jumps by the end of the term. Children will be able to use prior knowledge of shapes to construct their own routine in which they display to others.</p>	Computing	<p><u>Data information – grouping data</u></p> <p>This half term, the children will be introduced to data and information. They will begin using labels to place objects into groups. The children will then sort data into different groups to answer questions.</p>
				RE	<p><u>Christianity</u></p> <p>In RE this half term we will focus on the religion of Christianity and the beliefs of Christians. We will learn what holy book Christians follow and make a link to the celebration of Easter.</p>
Maths	<p>In maths, the children will start to learn addition and subtraction facts within 10. We will start to represent first, then and next equations both in addition and subtraction. Children will also begin to count forwards and backwards in 1's, 2's and 5's.</p>	Art/Design	<p><u>Design and technology</u></p> <p><u>Mechanics</u></p> <p>This term we are going to be creating our own interactive maps. Our theme will have the focus of London and its famous landmarks. Children will create a lever and evaluated how successful their map has been.</p>	Geography	<p>This term in geography we will be learning the following knowledge to help us answer the question of why do people visit London. Children will place London on a map, name and describe some of its famous landmarks and begin to recall how it has changed over time.</p>
