Writing and Reading	 <p>This term we have a range of books from 'A journey through space' by Steve Parker, 'Room on the broom' by Julia Donaldson and our class poem 'Zanzibar' by Jeanne Willis. We also have the whole school book called 'The bear and the piano' by David Litchfield. In our writing lessons, we will continue to write for different purposes. We will focus on creating a descriptive piece of writing and create a story.</p> <p>During phonics we will focus on growing our knowledge of graphemes that sound the same but do not look the same.</p>	Science	<p>Plants</p> <p>In science, we will be identifying a variety of common plants, including garden planets, wild plants and trees. We will also look at the basic structure of a variety of plants.</p>	Music	<p>In music this half term, we will listen and appraise the song 'Your Imagination' where we will learn to sing the song and find the pulse and rhythm to the song. Children will be able to use their imaginations to help finish the lyrics to the song.</p>
			PE	<p>Run, jump, throw</p> <p>Children will discuss and perform jumps, adapt their throwing technique depending on the object and distance.</p> <p>Send and return</p> <p>Children will be learning how to send a ball in different ways to their partners, rally and score points.</p>	PSHE
Phonics		PE		Computing	<p>Creating media – Digital writing</p> <p>This half term, the children will be introduced to typing on a keyboard and start to use tools to change the look of their writing.</p>
Maths	<p>In maths, the children will start to learn addition and subtraction facts within 20. We will start to explore using the knowledge of 10 and a bit, odd and even numbers within 20 and estimating length. Children will also begin to count forwards and backwards in 1's, 2's and 5's.</p>	Art	<p>Art Collage</p> <p>This term we are going to be creating our collages with the inspiration of the sky. Our skills will range from choosing our materials and arranging them to create our collages with the inspiration of Antoni Gaudi.</p>	RE	<p>Hinduism</p> <p>In RE this half term we will focus on the religion of Hinduism and the beliefs of Hindus. We will discuss who they worship and where they worship the Trimurti. We will also discuss what is important to us.</p>
				History	<p>This term in history we will be learning the knowledge to help us answer the question of 'Who's plane can travel the furthest?'. Children will be introduced to the Wright Brothers and their inventions and how this has impacted the world of today.</p>
