We will then look at the non-fiction text 'Black and British' by David Olusoga and the fiction text 'A Victorian Circus' by E.L Norry.</p>	<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">Science</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Living things and their habitats</u></p> <p>In science, Year 5 will be work scientifically by: observing and comparing the life cycles of plants and animals in their local environment with other plants and animals around the world. They will investigate and explore the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird. In conclusion they will describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.</p>	<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">PSHE</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Citizenship</u></p> <p>In this unit, the children will learn about parliament, the House of Commons and the House of Lords. The children will learn about how people can make change in their environment and have laws are created.</p>

In addition to this, the children will focus on studying Motown music in their weekly singing lessons.</p>	<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">Spansih</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Spanish</u></p> <p>In Spanish this term we will be learning about different types of music and using dictionaries to look up different instruments. We will be learning how to use 'porque' to give opinions. We will be making short raps/songs about our opinion on different food, sport and music.</p>

The children will learn how to multiply proper fractions, improper fractions and mixed numbers, dividing a fraction by a whole number, find fractions of quantity, to solve scaling problems, compare and order fractions, find equivalent fractions and finally recall common fraction-decimal equivalence.</p>		<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">Art</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Perspective</u></p> <p>In Art this half term, we will be looking at images that use perspective. We will then create our own one-point perspective images using a vanishing point.</p>	<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">RE</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Pilgrimages</u></p> <p>In RE, Year 5 will be learning about what a pilgrimage is; the significance of it for believers; and the specific destinations of pilgrimages for different faiths. We will look at the similarities and differences between the beliefs and practices and also share our own experiences of our own special journeys.</p>

They will learn that it was a period of major change in the way in which products made. They will explore the causes and consequences of the industrial revolution and the changes it brought to Britain. They will evaluate the legacy of the industrial revolution and its effect on Britain and the wider world.</p>		<p style="writing-mode: vertical-rl; transform: rotate(180deg);">PE</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Basketball</u></p> <p>Year 5 will be developing their basketball skills this term by combining skills such as pivoting, positioning and shooting. Year 5 will further their understanding of the rules within basketball, more specifically how to move forward when pivoting. We will be focusing on key terms including the triple threat position, creating space and winning a rebound.
