


Year 6 Curriculum Web – Summer 2 2022

Writing		<p>This half term we will be reading 'The Story of Flight' by Jakob Whitfield, 'Tamarind & the Star of Ishta' by Jasbinder Bilan and 'Beetle Boy' by M.G Leonard. We will then study 'Overheard in a Tower Block' by Joseph Coelho.</p> <p>In our reading sessions, we will be answering a range of questions based on the text such as retrieval, inference, summarising, giving impressions and vocabulary based.</p>	Science	<p><u>Living things and their Habitats</u></p> <p>In science, we will be continuing to learning about how living things are classified and why, with a focus on plants. We shall also finish our learning about micro-organisms. I know that the children are looking forward to seeing how much mould has grown.</p>	Computing	<p><u>Sensing</u></p> <p>The children will bring together elements of all four programming constructs: sequence from year 3, repetition from Year 4, selection from Year 5 and variable. They will be using a micro:bit to test the programmes that they create.</p>
Reading		<p>In our writing lessons we will be writing for a variety of purposes. We will be continuing to develop the use of a wide range of conjunctions and punctuation as well as varying out sentence structure.</p>	Music	<p><u>You've Got a Friend</u></p> <p>The children will be learning to listen and appraise songs. The children will have the opportunity to play instruments to accompany the song.</p>	PSHE	<p><u>Transition</u></p> <p>During summer 2, we shall be looking at the transition from primary school to secondary school. We shall look at changes that might happen and look at strategies we can use to help us if they get nervous. We shall also think about the exciting changes and things that we are looking forward to.</p>
Maths	<p>In maths, the children will be consolidating their learning from this year and filling in their gaps in order to prepare for secondary school.</p>		Art	<p><u>A Sense of Place</u></p> <p>The children will explore different street artists and messages that their art conveys. The children will learn how to use a viewfinder, create observational drawings and evaluate their art work.</p>	RE	<p><u>The Journey of Life</u></p> <p>We will look at ceremonies that we have at the beginning of our life, marking changes from childhood to adulthood, promises that people make at their wedding, emotions connected to love and leaving and ceremonies performed around death and the afterlife.</p>
Geography	<p><u>Overheating Planet</u></p> <p>In geography, the children will be learning about how we can affect the planet. They will be learning about the effects of global warming, fossil fuel resources of the UK, non-renewable energy sources on the climate, waste impacts on the environment and how land use can impact the environment.</p>		PE	<p><u>Athletics</u></p> <p>During our athletics unit, the children will develop their techniques in sprinting, throwing and jumping. They will learn about core athletic events and work on improving their personal best.</p>	Spanish	<p><u>Spanish</u></p> <p>In Spanish, children will be learning to describe a variety of weathers in the present tense, using the language of weather to describe typical climates in different places, use key language to describe features of Spain, learn how to say a lot and many and to say exactly where they live.</p>
