**Non-Chronological Report Writing**

Features	Remember to...
<p>To write a good non-chronological report:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• start with a title which tells your reader what your report is about;</li><li>• write an introduction giving the reader some brief information about the topic;</li><li>• use organisational devices to structure your text (e.g. sub-headings, bullet points);</li><li>• use a formal tone;</li><li>• use technical or topic language;</li><li>• end with a summary.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• use paragraphs to organise ideas;</li><li>• use the range of punctuation taught at key stage 2 neatly correctly;</li><li>• select language that shows good awareness of the reader;</li><li>• create auxiliary and grammatical structures that reflect what the writing requires;</li><li>• use verb tenses consistently and correctly throughout;</li><li>• use a range of devices to build cohesion (e.g. sub-headings of time and place);</li><li>• spell correctly most words from the year 6/9 or spelling list;</li><li>• maintain legibility in joined handwriting.</li></ul>
